Articles should be between 100 – 500 words in length, saved in Microsoft Word format.

Please include the title of your article in the Subject line of your e-mail, your full name, and your SSA Chapter name.

Photographs that are 1600 X 1200 pixels or greater will work best. It is important that you include a caption with every photograph that you submit; telling us who - from left to right - is in the photo, where and for what kind of event the photo was taken.

You can tell us what your chapter has been up to, such as Coffee Mornings, QHSE training that spouses have attended or how SSA Family Health day was organized in your chapter.
